

## Useful items to bring/send to Bwindi Community Hospital

In general, monetary donations are better for us than donated items. We can buy most of the things that we need in Kampala and it is always better to have a regular supplier rather than random items from overseas.

If people would prefer not to give money then there are some items that we would use:

### 1. Computing equipment:

**Laptop computers** for staff to use – we have the Internet but staff members are limited as we only have 20 computers between 120 people. We prefer **new or refurbished** laptops/Ipads in good condition that can be used for a longer period of time.

-8 port Switches to branch Ethernet connections for wired network

-Access Points or routers to expand wireless network

-Homeplug 1.0 - a device that transmits power and network signal over regular electrical grids. They work in pairs or more.

-Optical Mice and Keyboards.
